LOCATION: Brunswick Recreation Center, 3837 Center Road, Brunswick, OH 44212 – 330-273-8000

POOL: 25 yards by 6 lanes, locker rooms, multi-purpose room, bleachers on balcony & on deck, concessions, parking behind the building.

STARTING TIMES: Sunday morning session warm-up will be 7:30 – 8:00 a.m. for 9-10 boys and girls and 8:00-8:30a.m. for 8 and Under boys and girls, with competition starting at 8:35 a.m. Afternoon warm-up will begin 15 minutes after the conclusion of the morning session. The meet will start after a 45-minute warm-up session. Afternoon start times will be posted on www.lakeerieswimming.com web site on December 8, 2005.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be postmarked **on or before Monday, November 28, 2005** and received no later than **Wednesday, November 30, 2005**. **Electronic entries** must be received by **Monday, November 28, 2005**. The meet will be closed before the entry deadline if the sessions are estimated to be at four hours, so mail early. Mail entries to Tina Maddock, 125 Courtland St., Elyria, OH 44035 or e-mail dtcbmadd@alltel.net. **Telephone entries will not be accepted.** A Hy-Tek meet entry summary report (by swimmer) must accompany the entry that is submitted on disk or e-mail. Entries will not be accepted until the following is received by the above deadline: a check for the entry fee, a signed meet entry form and Hy-Tek summary report. All teams sending 10 or more swimmers should submit entries on disk compatible with SDIF format. Teams sending 10 or more swimmers, not on compatible SDIF format disk will be charged an administrative fee of \$1.00 per swimmer. This fee should be included in the meet entry check submitted.

ENTRY FEES: Individual events \$4.00; Relays: \$8.00; a \$2.00 per swimmer LESI surcharge. Fees must accompany all entries. Please pay all team entries with a single check and made payable **“BRUNSWICK REC SWIM TEAM”**.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS. Each swimmer may enter 5 individual events for the day exclusive of relays.

DECK ENTRIES. Fees will be \$8.00 per individual event, \$16.00 per relay. Deck entry swimmers new to meet will be charged \$2.00 surcharge and must provide proof of USA Swimming registration. Deck entries will be accepted on a space available basis only. Deck entries will be seeded at NO TIME (NT). No heats will be added. Deck entries will close 30 minutes prior to the start of each session.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmers must be athlete members of USA Swimming. Coaches must be current coach members of USA Swimming and must display their coach membership cards on deck. Age is as of the first day of the meet, December 11, 2005. On deck USA Swimming registration will be available (does not include coach registration).

QUALIFYING TIMES: Slower than “B” Time Standards. LESI swimmers must be equal to or slower than the qualifying times listed. Swimmers found to be faster than the qualifying time will be removed from the meet. NO REFUNDS. Deck-entered swimmers will be fined \$25.00 per event if found to be ineligible for the meet.

CONDUCT: The meet will be conducted according to the rules set forth in the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations. Events will be contested in a 25-yard course. All events are timed finals. Heats will be swum slowest to fastest. The Lake Erie scratch rule will be in effect and applies as follows:

Each swimmer/relay team shall be aware of the meet starting time and shall report to the proper meet authorities promptly upon call.

Pre-Seeded Meets - Each swimmer/relay team shall report promptly to the Clerk of Course prior to the race in which the swimmer/relay team is entered. Any swimmer/relay team not reporting for or competing in a timed final event or in a preliminary heat when finals are scheduled shall not be penalized.

Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given shall be disqualified. If the starting signal sounds before the disqualification is declared, the race shall continue and the swimmer or swimmers shall be disqualified upon completion of the race. If the disqualification is declared before the starting signal, the signal shall not be given, but the remaining swimmers shall be called back, be reminded by the starter of the penalties, and start again.

SEEDING & CHECK IN: All events except relays are PRE-SEEDED according to USA Swimming Rules. In accordance with 102.1.3, events may be seeded together but scored separately. There will be no penalty for failure to compete. Relay events will be checked in by returning cards with the swimmers names on them by an announced deadline during the meet.

CLERK OF COURSE: AM SESSION ONLY. PM SESSION heat/lane assignments will be posted by the coaches on the wall in the pool area and the entry to the pool area from the locker rooms.

AWARDS: Individual Events: - Ribbons 1st - 10th place
Relay Events: Ribbons 1st - 3th place
Heat winners will receive an award

ADMISSION COST: Adults \$4.00 (seniors 65 and over & children 8 & under are FREE)
Heat Sheets \$4.00 each session

SAFETY/WARM-UP: Lake Erie Swimming safety guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect at all times. Coaches must maintain contact with their swimmers during warm-up. All entry into the pool for warm-up is feet first from the starting block end of the pool. There is no diving during warm-up, except in designated sprint lanes. The final 15 minutes of each 30 minute a.m. session warm-up *and* 20 minutes of the p.m. session 45 minute warm-up shall be conducted as follows:

- (a) Lane 1 push/pace from the start end of the pool (or general warm-up at the discretion of Meet Referee or his/her designee).
- (b) Lanes 2 & 5 sprint lanes for racing starts from the starting block end of the pool, one length only and exiting the pool.
- (c) Lanes 3, 4, and 6 general warm-up, no diving or racing starts. Any or all of these lanes may be converted to sprint lanes at the discretion of the Meet Referee or his/her designee.

Swimmers are to sprint one way and climb out at the far end of the pool. Swimmers may be removed from warm-up for violating safety rules.

COACHES: Coaches packets will be available at the Admission table.

UNSUPERVISED SWIMMERS: Swimmers without coach supervision must contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee to be assigned to a coach on deck.

MERCHANDISE: The sale of swimwear and accessories will be available by CAS.

NOTE: Only athletes entered in the meet, working coaches, officials, and meet workers are allowed on deck. Other non-participants are expected to remain in the spectator area. We would appreciate if all participants and spectators clear their area of litter and personal belongings after each session.
